Elements of a Book

- Fiction = books with made up characters and events
- Nonfiction = books with real characters and events

Main Idea and Theme

- · Main Idea = what the book is mostly about
- Theme = message, lesson, or moral of story



Summarizing

- Written in order and short description of main events or information in story
- · What happened and why

Characterization

- A character's personality not physical appearance or feelings
- · Character can change throughout the book

Making Connections

- Text to self = connecting story to own life
- Text to text = connecting characters, setting, events from one story to another
- Text to world = connecting story to world history, school, and/ or community
