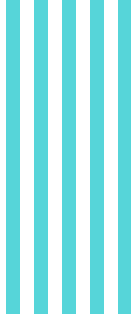
MISSING MOMMY



VERY IMPORTANT PART (V.I.P) FICTION

During retelling, readers are asked to recall everything they can remember. As texts get longer, it is impossible to recall every detail. Identifying the **Very Important Part (V.I.P.)** will help students determine the **main idea** or **central message** in the texts. After reading the story, students are asked to identify two important feelings and two important actions of the main character. Then, explain their reasoning for choosing those specific feelings/actions.



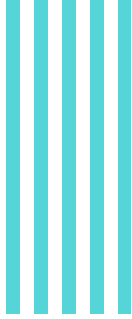


VERY IMPORTANT PART (V.I.P) FICTION
